The number of available seats on offer between London and Dubai, the largest city in the United Arab Emirates, has tripled over the last decade, according to data from air transport information company Ascend. The second fastest-growing route is between London and Chicago, followed by London-Hong Kong and Melbourne-Singapore. The number of seats available between London and Dubai has soared to 1.25 million in the first half of 2006 compared with 405,433 in 1996.
